2015-2016 Freshman Morgan Rich is the newest addition to our team. She joined the Sooners as a mid-year transfer from Kentucky and will sit out the remainder of the regular season and the fall semester of the 2016-2017 season. She was ranked the No. 30 player in the nation in the class of 2015 by ESPN Hoop Gurlz and averaged 20 points and 7.1 rebounds at Allen County-Scottsville, KY High School. Morgan led her high school to the KHSAA state championship game during the 2014-2015 season and earned all-state first-team honors.
